

Community Leader J. Scott Pidcock Appointed as a Trexler Trustee

By order of the Court of Common Pleas of Lehigh County, J. Scott Pidcock has been appointed to a ten-year term as a Trustee of the Harry C. Trexler Trust beginning May 22, 2017.

“The appointment of Scott Pidcock as a Trexler Trustee is welcome news. Scott has lived in and served our community throughout his lifetime. He will bring significant knowledge and great understanding of local needs to his work as a Trustee,” said Jamie P. Musselman, current Chair of the Trust. “Scott is an engineer and a businessman who has applied his considerable skills to the numerous local charitable organizations that he has served. Mr. Pidcock is a native and resident of Allentown and Lehigh County where he and his wife, Gillian, raised their three children. He graduated from William Allen High School.

Mr. Pidcock is a registered architect and a registered professional engineer. He received a Bachelor of Science Degree with honors in civil engineering from Lafayette College, a Master of Architecture Degree and a Master of Structural Engineering Degree from the University of Virginia and a Master of Arts Degree in Religion from Yale University.

Mr. Pidcock is principal of The Pidcock Company, founded in Allentown in 1924, a civil engineering, land planning, architecture and land surveying firm.

Mr. Pidcock’s service for the benefit of the community includes trustee of the Rider-Pool Foundation, member of the Allentown Art Museum Board of Trustees and Executive Committee, member of the Cedar Crest College Board of Trustees, board member of the Wildlands Conservancy and the Baum School of Art, member of the Board of Trustees and Executive Committee of Moravian Academy. Mr. Pidcock also has served as an Elder and Member of Board of Session of First Presbyterian Church of Allentown and as a member of the Yale University Divinity School Board of Advisors.

Mr. Pidcock will assume the role of Trustee due to the retirement of Daniel G. Gambet, O.S.F.S., who served with distinction as a Trexler Trustee for twenty years and has been named Trustee *Emeritus*.
